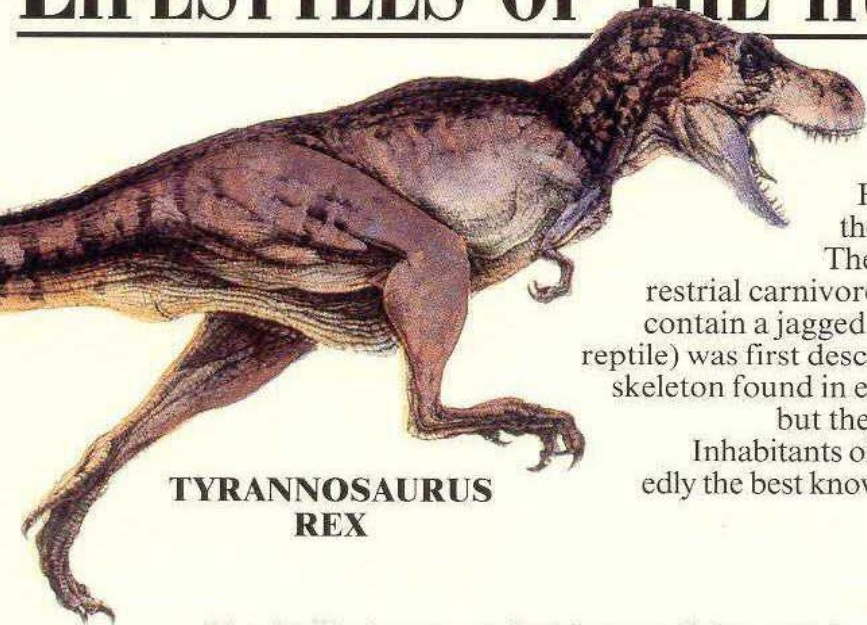
Proceed with Caution. Although we've thought of every safety precaution imaginable, please use good judgment when approaching the T-Rex Paddock or Velociraptor Pen.

More Tips for Travelers. Several major U.S. airlines serve San Jose, Costa Rica, and from there you can travel to Isla Nublar by boat.

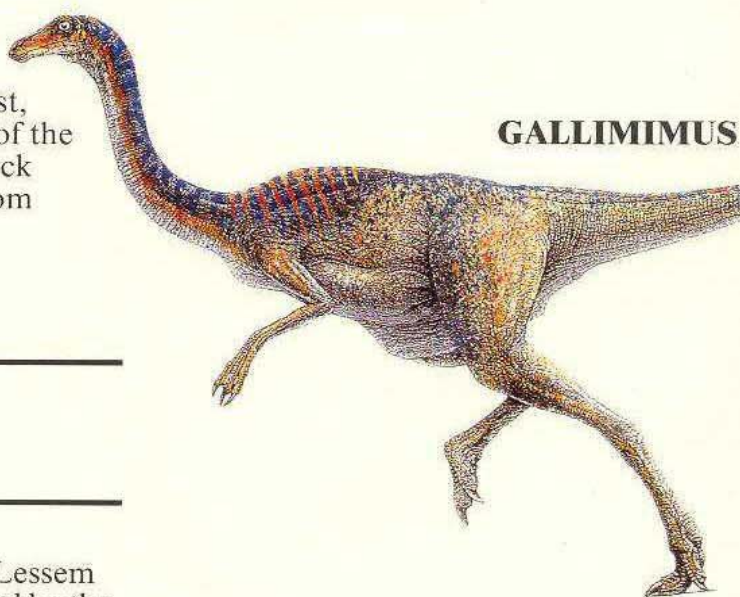

TYRANNOSAURUS REX

Here are two more of Jurassic Park's illustrious residents:

He's the king of the jungle, the class bully, the top dog and the heavyweight boxing champion of the prehistoric world. The T-rex, as he is most frequently called, is the largest terrestrial carnivore, sometimes measuring 40 ft. long.



GALLIMIMUS

The Gallimimus was the biggest of the ostrich-like dinosaurs, up to 20 ft. long. They are very fast, but not always fast enough to avoid the clutches of the Tyrannosaurus rex.
